## True Purperea foliage

Blaze's colour depends where in Australia it is grown. In Sydney it has Purperea coloured foliage, usually commencing from early autumn through to the end of

September. In cold climates it can have the Purperea foliage for most of the year, often even into the beginning of summer. The fact that it does turn green in summer allows it to survive the heat waves Australia is famous for. This is not a weak plant, it is in fact one of our toughest. In low maintenance mass planting areas for

Brisbane it really needs light shade, although it does well in a garden with some care. From Sydney south it does fine in full sun. It's only the extra humidity of Queensland that requires the light shade.

In WA, SA, Vic, and NSW Blaze Dianella tasmanica 'NWP2' is set to replace Phormiums and Cordylines that so often burn in the hot Aussie sun. Blaze is just far more heat tolerant. The deep colours shown are its real colour, year after year, for on average 5 to 9 months of the year depending where in Australia.
