Dianella caerulea 'DCNCO' (PBR)

Sep-Nov April-Oct

The common form of *Dianella caerulea* has tall, messy straw brown canes that often fall. Breeze does not have this problem.

Dianella caerulea is a great plant for commercial and residential landscaping. The only problem is as it gets older, it becomes untidy. Breeze solves this problem by providing a 'no cane' variety, that does not have above ground canes. *Dianella caerulea* - Breeze, is the tidy tough ground cover plant, that is 40% larger than Little Jess. Breeze is a very fast to establish *Dianella*. It may need trimming after 1-3 years then not for a while, particularly in Queensland.



Breeze fills in the gaps

Breeze is able to cope with hot humidity, heat and drought in the summer. It is better in the cold than most other *Dianella caerulea*s. After the first trim, it is very low maintenance - trim approximately once every 4 to 6 years on average. Its underground rhizomes spread well, filling the gaps and outcompeting weeds.
