Dianella caerulea 'DBB03' 

Cassa Blue's form is more of a clumping *Dianella caerulea* rather than spreading.

Its stunning blue foliage, and highly desirable size and shape, make it the ideal plant for commercial landscape, and home garden design. It flowers longer and more than any other *Dianella* known to us. Cassa Blue is slower growing, but once established is very tough where it benefits from fertilising yearly and annual trimming to keep at its best. It is very popular in WA, SA and Victoria. In WA it even does well in very windy coastal positions. Needs dryer soils in Sydney and Brisbane.

In some ways Cassa Blue has the shape of a dwarf *Phormium*, but it is far tougher. Its blue colour provides great contrast in any garden or landscape design. Avoid wet feet in hot humid areas. (See Specification sheets for your region. www.ozbreed.com.au)
