Little Rev provides an excellent contrast to green plants like Liriope.

Dianella 'Little Rev' will provide Landscape Architects & Designers, Councils & Landscapers a plant that is stunning in appearance and has great architectural upright foliage with brilliant foliage colour contrast. This is a very hardy plant that will require little maintenance once established. Dianella 'Little Rev' has an average mature height of around 300mm,

which makes it ideal for roadsides, median strips, roundabouts, car parks, golf courses and ornamental gardens. 'Little Rev' is a great roadside plant; with its

beautiful blue-grey colour, it's just terrific! For more humid areas like Sydney or Brisbane, it works well when planted in raised areas or good draining conditions. This is less of a concern in Melbourne, Adelaide, Perth etc. In hot humid conditions, avoid planting in areas that get periodic wet feet. If after 2 to 3 years its leaves look tired in hot humid areas (Sydney & Brisbane), simply trim back close to the base. Avoid trimming in times of drought and hot weather.
