## Ozbreed has bred many wonderful forms of native grass over the years.

*Pennisetum alopecuroides* is probably the showiest and most beautiful native grass. It is a variable specie, from which Ozbreed has managed to breed some interesting variations including Nafray which is a very tough, more compact variety that is well suited for mass planting. It has finer texture, is more drought tolerant, and has a better winter colour. The reliability of Nafray has seen it planted by the millions.

### **Don't be confused...**

In this photo on the right, we have the flowers of two varieties of *Pennisetum*. On the left side of the photo is the native, non-invasive *Pennisetum alopecuroides*. On the right side of the photo is the highly invasive African variety of *Pennisetum setaceum*. Unfortunately many people often confuse the native for the exotic and vice-versa. With millions of Nafray planted nation wide, it is a safe choice. After 9 years it has not caused weed problems.



DESCRIPTION	Showy, compact clumping grass
HEIGHT & WIDTH	60cm x 60cm
POSITION	Full sun to partial shade. Drought and frost tolerant
CARE	Trim to 1/3 size in May - August or when required
USES	Mass planting. Accent plant for rockeries and borders
SOIL TYPE	Sandy to heavy clay soils
