Imperata cylindrica 'ICL200' (PBR)

Beautiful Australian native grass.

This Australian native grass will add interest and flare to any landscape, with many months of fluffy plumes. Yalba is a compact, spreading, dense grass ideal for roadsides, slopes, median strips or any large landscaped area where an almost indestructible, drought and frost tolerant plant is needed.

- Compact form - 30 to 50 percent shorter than the common form.
- More prolific, longer lasting fluffy plumes, regularly up to 4 to 5 months. Usually April to August.
- Extremely drought and frost tolerant.
- Tolerates most soil types including very poor soils.
- Excellent erosion control plant. Strengthens the soil 5.45 times.
- Locks up more carbon in the soil than most grasses.
- Gets very dense and outcompetes weeds.
- Trim or slash yearly around late February or March to achieve masses of white plumes.
- It will spread, so it is best to plant as a monoculture.

Uniform height

DESCRIPTION	Reddish foliage in Winter, with fast growing spread
HEIGHT & WIDTH	40-60cm x 100cm
POSITION	Full sun or part shade
CARE	No or low maintenance. Not suited for garden planting
USES	Ideal for ground cover for roadsides, slopes, median strips
SOIL TYPE	Sandy to heavy clay soils
