- Great Liriope with denser foliage and a finer leaf - better border option than Mondo for shade or sun
- Lawn alternative ground cover that only needs to be mown once a year in winter to keep looking good
- Low growing at around 210mm high, lower if mown twice per year
- Beautiful light pink flowers in summer

HEIGHT & WIDTH	Max height of 40cm x 50cm
POSITION	Full sun to heavy shade
CARE	Cut or mow back to ground level in late winter
USES	Dense ground cover or border plant
SOIL TYPE	All soil types

Lomandra hystrix 'LHBYF' 

Adaptable: performs in wet summers or dry summers

Still flowering beautifully year after year



- Stunning scented flowers that last from September to November year after year
- A stand out native plant as a feature
- Can be used in wet and dry landscapes

# MUNDI™

Westringia fruticosa 'WES05' 

Tough architectural ground cover



- Great as a flat hedge in gardens and landscapes
- Low growing ground cover that grows to 40cm high
- Almost no maintenance, can be left unpruned or manicured like in the top photo

DESCRIPTION	Tough, beautiful ground cover Westringia
HEIGHT & WIDTH	30-50 cm x 1.5 m
POSITION	Full sun to part shade; heat, humidity, frost
CARE	Prune to shape every 12-24 months or leave unpruned
USES	Mass plantings, low maintenance areas
SOIL TYPE	Most soil types
