- Little Gold™ Abelia contrasts well with green, red and blue foliage plants for endless design possibilities.
- A compact, tidy plant that forms a dense shrub. Alternatively, it can be used as a ground cover when pruned once or twice a year.
- It has reasonable drought tolerance and is moderately frost tolerant.

Density	1–3 per m ² 2–3 per linear metre
Flowering	N/A
Best Planting Time	August–May
Uses	Specimen planting, hedge, pruned ground cover, mass planting, wide border plant
Position	Full sun to part shade
Soil Type	Free draining soils; if in heavy soils, plant in a raised garden bed.
Care	Prune annually if required to remove old foliage; more frequent light pruning required if being used as a hedging plant or ground cover
