

Blue Gem[™] Westringia is the most vivid flowering Westringia we have ever seen.

- Produces amazing bluish-purple flowers with a bushy growth that responds very well to pruning.
- Will flower profusely in spring, and regularly at other times of the year.
- Great in native gardens or in any flower garden and can be pruned to shape as required.
- Do not use in heavy clay soils in depressed areas where it will be sitting in water, it can cause fungal problems. This plant isn't recommended for rain gardens.
