



Aranda™ Dianella is an ideal tidy border plant with clean foliage.

- Aranda™ Dianella is a compact, dwarf variety with slightly arching deep green foliage. It has cleaner foliage than other compact forms.
- This is a cane-less Dianella with very tight rhizome growth and a small spread.
- It grows well in coastal and inland climates.
- The Aranda™ plant has shown evergreen frost hardiness to -4°C with only some leaf discolouration. It will brown off in Canberra winters.

Description	Compact, cane-less, dwarf Dianella
Density	6–12 plants per m ² 3–6 per linear metre
Height & Width	30cm x 35cm
Flowering	Deep blue flowers from Sep–Oct
Best Planting Time	March–October
Uses	Tidy border plant, mass plantings
Position	Full sun to shade Tolerates frost, drought & humidity
Soil Type	Sandy loam to free draining clay soils; avoid very poor soil
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; cut back to half the height every 3–5 years
Where It Works	NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA, WA & QLD
