Correa reflexa 'COR7' (b)

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

A compact, dense form with bigger flowers and low pruning requirements.

- Bellissimo™ Correa is a low spreading, compact plant with large pink and yellow bells.
- It will grow beautifully in southern landscaped gardens, but with its tight growth habit, Bellissimo™ Correa is also an excellent garden pot plant that will really shine.
- This shrub only requires pruning once a year to maintain its compact habit.

Description	Compact and dense shrub
Density	2-5 plants per m ² 2-4 plants per linear metre
Height & Width	50cm x 1m (smaller with pruning)
Flowering	Large pink and yellow bells in winter/early spring
Best Planting Time	Spring and autumn
Uses	Pot plants, small garden landscapes and mass planting; honey eating birds are highly attracted to this plant
Position	Full sun to light shade Tolerates drought & frost
Soil Type	Preferably reasonably drained soil, however it is adaptable to most soil types
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; it has low water requirements once established; prune once per year to maintain compact habit; use slow release native fertiliser
Where it Works	VIC, ACT, SA, WA, TAS, Southern NSW and Sydney (in good draining soils)
