Dianella caerulea 'DBB03' (l)

STRAPPY LEAF PLANTS

Cassa Blue® Dianella has a compact, clumping habit with stunning blue foliage.

- It is the perfect size and compact shape for commercial and residential landscapes.
- One of the longest flowering Dianellas.
- The Cassa Blue® plant has great winter colour.
- The Cassa Blue® plant performs well in coastal WA and SA climates and is consequently very popular. It loves windy coastal conditions in WA.
- Cassa Blue® Dianella is not highly recommended for mass planting in Canberra. Needs dryer soils in Sydney.

Description	Clumping, compact rich blue foliage
Density	4–8 plants per m ² 2–4 per linear metre
Height & Width	50cm x 40cm
Flowering	Masses of purple & yellow flowers from September–November
Best Planting Time	March–November
Uses	Garden or specimen planting
Position	Full sun to partial shade Tolerates drought & cold
Soil Type	Wide variety of soils; avoid very poor soil
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; remove older leaves as required or cut back halfway every 3–5 years
Where it Works	ACT, VIC, SA, WA, TAS, NSW (north of Sydney only for maintained gardens) & QLD (only for maintained gardens)
