## An ultra compact Phormium with minty green and chocolate brown foliage.

- Chocomint Mist™ Phormium tolerates heavy frost and moderate dry conditions.
- Ensure it isn't planted with the crown of the plant below soil level, as it will not thrive as good as it should.
- In humid areas such as Sydney, this ultra compact Phormium should be planted around March to October for the best results.

<b>Description</b>	Ultra compact, chocomint colour
<b>Density</b>	6-10 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 3-5 per linear metre
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	40cm x 40cm
<b>Flowering</b>	N/A
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March–October
<b>Uses</b>	Mass plantings as a low border or fill in plant, specimen planting
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to part shade Tolerates frost & drought
<b>Soil Type</b>	Tolerates a wide variety of soils
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; needs water in summer; do not cover base of plant with mulch or soil; remove older foliage as required, or cut back to half the height every 2–5 years
<b>Where It Works</b>	VIC, TAS, SA, WA, ACT & NSW (not suited to north of Sydney and QLD)
