Agapanthus orientalis 'CLOUDY DAYS' (b)

HARDY EXOTIC PLANTS

Rarely produces seed and provides stunning dual coloured flowers.

- 'Cloudy Days' is a mid-sized Agapanthus with dual colour flower heads that bloom in summer. It also displays glossy green straplike foliage.
- Grows up to 1m tall and suits sunny positions, but will tolerate shady positions.
- Remove spent flowers and dispose of them correctly if near bushland. Very disease, frost and drought tolerant.
- Ideal for the waterwise gardener and looks great in a patio pot or as a border.

Density	3-6 plants per m ² 2-3 per linear metre
Height & Width	1m x 80cm
Flowering	White/blue flowers from Dec-Jan
Best Planting Time	March-November
Uses	Garden beds, borders, patio pots & planter boxes
Position	Full sun to moderate shade; drought & frost tolerant
Soil Type	Most soil types
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; remove older leaves and spent flower stems as required
Where it Works	QLD, NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA & WA
