

# Crimson Tide™

*Correa pulchella* 'COR9' (L)

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

This strong grower has clean green foliage with masses of vivid flowers.

- Crimson Tide™ Correa is a vigorous, low spreading form with remarkable vivid pink flowers.
- This plant has a denser appearance and is great for residential and commercial landscapes.

| <b>Description</b>        | Low, spreading ground cover   |
| <b>Density</b>            | 1-3 plants per m <sup>2</sup><br>1-2 plants per linear metre  |
| <b>Height &amp; Width</b> | 50cm x 2m (smaller with pruning)  |
| <b>Flowering</b>          | Vivid pink bells in winter/early spring   |
| <b>Best Planting Time</b> | Autumn and winter   |
| <b>Uses</b>               | Bird attracting ground cover plant for residential and commercial mass planting, or as a specimen plant in smaller gardens  |
| <b>Position</b>           | Full sun to light shade<br>Tolerates drought & frost  |
| <b>Soil Type</b>          | Preferably reasonably drained soil, however it is adaptable to most soil types  |
| <b>Care</b>               | Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; prune yearly to keep its dense growth habit, or twice a year for a manicured look; use a native slow release fertiliser |
| <b>Where it Works</b>     | VIC, ACT, SA, WA, TAS, Southern NSW and Sydney (in good draining soils)   |
