A compact Baloskion ideal for rain gardens or shaded landscapes.

- This plant has the beauty of the common form with a much smaller height, making it ideal for modern landscapes. Baloskion was formerly known as Restio.
- In full sun, it is good for moist, wet or boggy sites and watercourses, planting near ponds or in shallow areas of ponds. It is also great as a feature in a pot.
- Prefers moist conditions, but can also work in relatively dry areas, particularly if shaded and irrigated.
- This plant won't seed, self sow or become weedy because it is dioecious, meaning it has separate male and female plants. It gets very few pests or diseases.

Best Planting Time	March-October
Uses	Moist, wet or shady sites; pots
Position	Full sun to heavy shade; tolerates humidity & moderate frost
Soil Type	Heavy clay to sandy soil types
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; prefers to be moist; can tolerate dry if irrigated; fertilise in spring if required; cut back halfway every 3-5 years
