## Tougher than other purpurea Phormiums, yet more vivid.

- Although the Flamin'<sup>®</sup> plant is a single coloured Phormium, its foliage boasts red, orange and bronze tones, especially when in sunlight, it literally glows.
- This Phormium tolerates heavy frost, moderately dry conditions and is low maintenance once established.
- It handles the heat much better than most Phormiums.
- When planting Flamin'<sup>®</sup> Phormium, ensure the crown or base of the plant is not below soil level. Apply coarse grade mulch to reduce weed growth and keep the root zone cold and moist. Avoid summer planting.

<b>Description</b>	Semi-compact, tri-tone Phormium
<b>Density</b>	1-4 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 1-2 per linear metre
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	80-90cm x 80-90cm
<b>Flowering</b>	N/A
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March-October
<b>Uses</b>	Mass plantings, rockeries or ornamental gardens
<b>Position</b>	Full sun or partly shaded positions Tolerates frost & drought
<b>Soil Type</b>	Tolerates a wide variety of soil types
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established, then water as required; ensure base of plant is not below soil level; remove older leaves as required and cut back halfway every 4-5 years
<b>Where It Works</b>	VIC, TAS, SA, WA, ACT & NSW (not suited to north of the Central Coast and QLD)
