## Free Fall™ *Casuarina* is an ideal erosion control tool for slopes.

- A low cost alternative to covering large areas of ground—each plant spreads about 2–3 metres in a couple of years and basically hugs the ground.
- Free Fall™ *Casuarina* can be used as a super tough roadside plant, or to cover retaining walls (up to 5m high).
- *Casuarina*'s are normally a tree, so to be found in a ground cover form is magic.
- The Free Fall™ plant provides the landscape industry with a wonderful evergreen ground cover.
