

Frilly Lace™

Lomandra multiflora 'VER1' (b)



A prolific flowering Lomandra.

- Frilly Lace™ Lomandra is one of the best flowering Lomandras around with its large, intricate yellow flowers.
- This is a spring flowering plant, producing masses of perfumed lacey flowers among its strappy green foliage.
- Frilly Lace™ Lomandra is frost and drought tolerant. It generally doesn't need much care once established.

Description	Evergreen Lomandra with showy, intricate yellow flowers
Density	3-5 plants per m ² 2-3 per linear metre
Height & Width	45cm x 45cm
Flowering	Yellow flowers in spring
Best Planting Time	March-November
Uses	Specimen or group plantings
Position	Full sun to moderate shade Tolerates frost & drought
Soil Type	Most soil types, prefers free draining soils
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; prune every 3-5 years; remove old flower stems as required; use slow release fertiliser in spring if needed
Where It Works	NSW, ACT, VIC, SA, WA & TAS
