*Lomandra longifolia* 'MURU' ↴

## STRAPPY LEAF PLANTS

**A variegated form of Lomandra with bigger flowers and a more dense, compact form.**

- A clean growing, uniform, non-seeding Lomandra.
- This plant is similar to 'Katrinus Deluxe' Lomandra, but with a variegated twist.
- Looks amazing planted en masse. Also looks good in specimen plantings and commercial plantings such as roadsides, golf courses, factories and offices.
- Lives on natural rainfall in most populated areas in Australia. Occasional top up watering will be required in extreme drought.
- Tolerates windy and salt laden windy positions, but avoid foredune situations too close to the beach.
