STRAPPY LEAF PLANTS

The best performing, Australian native rain garden plant.

- Stunning, highly perfumed flowers that last from September to November year after year, sometimes repeat flowering in autumn.
- It is an adaptable plant that works in wet and dry.
- In research, Katie Belles™ *Lomandra* strengthened the soil 285%, so it is suitable for areas requiring erosion control (2007 Paananen, Layt; Study).
- Extremely resistant to root rot and will tolerate excessively wet areas.
- Katie Belles™ *Lomandra hystrix* can be used in most landscape situations including raised, flat and depressed planting sites.
- Highly recommended for mass planting in humid climates like Sydney, Northern NSW and Queensland.

Height & Width	1.5–1.8m x 1.2–1.5m
Flowering	Masses of perfumed yellow flowers from September–November
Best Planting Time	March–November
Uses	Feature planting and mass planting; great for periodically wet areas
Position	Full sun to heavy shade; Tolerates humidity, cold & drought
Soil Type	Sandy loam to heavy clay soils
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; occasional watering will be required in very dry conditions; cut back 30cm above the ground every 3–7 years
Where it Works	QLD, NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA & WA
