*Corymbia citriodora* 'COR81' (b)

## Improved bushy, compact form of the popular Lemon Scented Gum.

- This dwarf sized tree will form a dense canopy with a multi stemmed trunk.
- The beauty of Lemon Squash™ Corymbia is that it does not have the propensity to drop limbs and make a nuisance of itself like the much taller form can.
- Lemon Squash™ Corymbia is ideally suited for street tree plantings, smaller home gardens and any type of landscape. It will be a favourite for councils and landscapers due to its versatility with a smaller height.
- It will tolerate many soil types and climatic conditions but will need protection from frost when young.
- Lemon Squash™ Corymbia will respond well to pruning and features the smooth grey bark and lovely lemon scented foliage when crushed that the species is renowned for.

<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March–November
<b>Uses</b>	Street plantings, small home gardens etc.
<b>Position</b>	Full sun; tolerates drought
<b>Soil Type</b>	Sandy loam to light clay soil types
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; will need protection from frost when young; responds well to pruning
<b>Where it Works</b>	SA, WA, VIC, NSW, QLD
