- Years ago Silver Streak™ Dianella became popular due to its white and green foliage, but the plant did not perform long term in most Australian conditions. Now a similar colour contrast can be achieved with a super reliable long lived plant.
- The Australian native Lucky Stripe™ Lomandra hystrix 'LMV200' (b does not produce viable seed, so it will stay where it is planted.
