## NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

### A tough, beautiful and versatile ground cover *Westringia*.

- Can be left unpruned and still maintain a tidy form, or can be pruned into any low growing architectural shape.
- With masses of white flowers, this plant is low growing and requires less pruning.
- Ideal for tough roadsides, mass plantings as a ground cover in gardens, and large amenity areas.
- Great for where you need a low growing plant that requires minimal care.
- More regular pruning will result in a tidier, denser ground cover.
- Tough enough to live on natural rainfall in most populated areas on the east coast of Australia.

<b>Description</b>	Tough, beautiful ground cover
<b>Density</b>	1–3 plants per m <sup>2</sup>
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	40–50cm x 1.5m
<b>Flowering</b>	White flowers from Sep–Apr
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March–November
<b>Uses</b>	Great for mass plantings, low maintenance areas
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to part shade Tolerates drought & cold
<b>Soil Type</b>	Sandy to well drained clay soils
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; almost no maintenance; prune to shape 1–3 times a year after flowering, every few years for a natural shape
<b>Where it Works</b>	QLD, NSW, VIC, TAS, SA, WA & ACT (Prefers shelter from heavy frost in ACT)
