## STRAPPY LEAF PLANTS

### The toughest Lomandra for coastal landscapes and salt laden winds.

- Versatile, low maintenance, drought and cold hardy, working well inland or on the coast.
- Nyalla® Lomandra has evergreen fine leaf foliage, does not produce seed and is very tolerant of salt laden winds.
- It looks like a grass tree, but is trunkless, faster growing and doesn't need annual trimming.
- Great for commercial and home landscapes. It can be used in roadside plantings, feature plantings and patio pots. Its cut foliage even makes great fillers for vases.
- Good erosion control—the Nyalla® plant strengthens the soil 328% (2007 Paananen, Layt; Study).

<b>Uses</b>	Mass planting & specimen planting

<b>Soil Type</b>	Sandy, sandy loam to clay soils
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; cut back 30cm above the ground every 3-10 years if required
