Gardenia augusta 'KEN04' (b)

HARDY EXOTIC PLANTS

A great dwarf Gardenia with a softer, fine leaf appearance.

- O So Fine™ Gardenia has a much finer leaf, shorter height and masses of white flowers. It produces many flowers due to its shorter internodes.
- This is a much denser *Gardenia augusta* making the O So Fine™ plant a better ground cover choice, particularly for outcompeting weeds.
- Requires full sun to part shade and will require protection from heavy frosts.
- Prefers moist well drained soils and needs to be kept moist in dry weather.

Description	Fine leaf dwarf Gardenia; lots of white flowers
Density	1–3 plants per m ² 1.5–3 per linear metre
Height & Width	Approx. 30cm x 1m
Flowering	White flowers in late spring; spot flowering in warmer months
Best Planting Time	March–October
Uses	Ground cover, border plant, containers
Position	Full sun to part shade; drought tolerant
Soil Type	Well drained moist soils
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; keep moist in dry weather, protect from heavy frost; trim 1–2 times a year
Where it Works	QLD, NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA & WA
