

# Ocean Reef™

*Hibbertia spicata* 'WA01' (b)

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

## A compact Hibbertia with very glossy leaves.

- Ocean Reef™ Hibbertia is a relatively slow growing, small shrub that does not tend to elongate.
- It has a tight structure with small, glossy leaves.
- This Hibbertia provides a strong show of yellow buttercup flowers in spring.
- Excellent in coastal and limestone locations, as it will tolerate higher pH.
- Has proven sound in containers for periods up to 18 months, but Ocean Reef™ Hibbertia is best as a bedded plant with sound nutrient and moisture.
- Needs sun every available day but will tolerate half day shade if kept warm and not too wet.

<b>Description</b>	Compact, small shrub with glossy leaves
<b>Density</b>	3 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 2 per linear metre
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	50cm x 25cm
<b>Flowering</b>	Yellow buttercup flowers early to mid spring
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March to November
<b>Uses</b>	Specimen plant, low hedge, coastal use
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to half day shade; drought tolerant
<b>Soil Type</b>	Moist sand or light loam; likes limestone and above normal pH; responds well to nutrient supplement
<b>Care</b>	Water as needed for 8–13 weeks until established; prune as required
<b>Where it Works</b>	WA & SA
