ADVANCED TREES

Pinnacle™ Syzygium is a very narrow growing native tree for tight areas, providing a sculptured design for impact.

- Retains a compact upright form which makes it excellent for hedging, screening or compact planting zones such as town houses.
- Pinnacle™ Syzygium can reach over 8m in height but is usually smaller in cultivation—can be pruned down to 2m.
- Leaves are rounded, bright and glossy green with attractive contrasting reddish brown new growth.
- Pinnacle™ Syzygium has white duster flowers followed by large, fleshy, red/pink delicious tasting fruits in profusion.
- Suits most soils but prefers moist conditions.

Density	1 plant per 1–2m ² 1–1.5 per liner metre
Height & Width	6–10m x 1–1.5m
Flowering	White duster flowers from Nov–Dec
Best Planting Time	March–November
Uses	Tight planting zones, along fences & driveways
Position	Full sun to part shade Tolerates drought & cold
Soil Type	Moist, well drained soils
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; be aware of Psyllid (using Yates confidor tablets yearly is recommended); prune yearly for a tidy hedge or every 2–3 years as a screen plant
Where it Works	QLD, NSW, VIC, SA & WA
