



## Prestige® Dianella has masses of blue flowers in spring with fine darker leaves.

- A fine leaf *Dianella revoluta* with a darker, deeper coloured foliage.
- It forms a very attractive clump and as it matures, the leaves fold over slightly, giving it good ground coverage.
- Prestige® Dianella has a real abundance of blue flowers, sitting well above the foliage.
- It is quite different from other *Dianella revolutas* with its ability to profusely flower, its finer leaf and its unique clumping foliage.

<b>Description</b>	Fine leaf Dianella, deep green coloured foliage
<b>Density</b>	4-6 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 2-3 per linear metre
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	50cm x 60-70cm
<b>Flowering</b>	Blue flowers from Oct-Nov
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	April-October
<b>Uses</b>	Specimen or mass planting
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to moderate shade Tolerates frost & drought
<b>Soil Type</b>	Moderately heavy to free draining soils
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; remove older leaves as required; cut back 15cm above the ground every 3-5 years if required
<b>Where It Works</b>	VIC, ACT, TAS, SA, WA & Southern NSW (not suited north of Sydney)
