Loropetalum chinense 'PEACK' (L)

HARDY EXOTIC PLANTS

Purple Pixie™ Loropetalum is perfect for garden beds and containers for colour contrast.

- A dwarf ground cover with a weeping habit.
- Rich purple foliage is complimented by its showy pink, ribbon-like flowers in spring.
- Pruning every 2–4 years will keep it below 30 cm.
- Purple Pixie™ Loropetalum prefers to be fertilised in early spring and to be pruned as required after flowering.

Description	Purple dwarf, weeping ground cover
Density	2–3 plants per m ² 2–3 per linear metre
Height & Width	30–50cm x 1.2–1.5m
Flowering	Pink flowers late winter/early spring
Best Planting Time	March–November
Uses	Colour contrast for garden beds and containers
Position	Full sun to part shade; cold tolerant
Soil Type	Well drained soils with adequate moisture
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; use slow release fertiliser in early spring; prune very 3–4 years to keep below 30cm (prune more frequently if required)
Where it Works	QLD, NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA & WA
