

Red Fence™

Photinia X fraseri 'CP01' (b)



The perfect plant for a fence size hedge or short screen, with red new growth.

- Compact, strong growing Photinia.
- Red new growth foliage with crinkled, ornamental leaves.
- Only needs yearly pruning, which is half that of regular Photinia. Although pruning twice a year will result in a tighter hedge.

Description	Compact, strong growing Photinia
Density	1-2 per m ² 2 per linear metre for hedging
Height & Width	1.5m x 1m after 5 years, reaches 2m high in good soil types
Flowering	Small white flowers in mid to late spring
Best Planting Time	March–November
Uses	As a fence, short screen or hedge
Position	Full sun to part shade; frost tolerant
Soil Type	Most soil types
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; use slow release fertiliser yearly; prune 1–2 times a yr for a tight hedge
Where It Works	South QLD, NSW, ACT, TAS, SA & WA
