Beautiful red edged foliage that can handle heat and frost.

- A Dianella with green to bronzed coloured leaves and a distinctive red coloured tinge to the edge of the leaf.
- Ruby Green™ Dianella will display red tinged foliage through autumn, winter and spring but will become less noticeable through the summer to cope with the heat.
- An attractive Dianella flowering in early to mid October.
- Ideal as a colour contrast plant for small mass plantings, border plantings and for general landscape use.
- Ruby Green™ Dianella has the ability to cope with dry periods, heat, frost and humidity.

Density	4-6 plants per m ² 2-3 per linear metre
Height & Width	Approx 60cm x 40-50cm
Flowering	September-November
Best Planting Time	March-November
Uses	Landscape and garden plantings
Position	Full sun to part shade Drought & frost tolerant
Soil Type	Sandy to well drained clay soils
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established, then as needed; use slow release fertiliser in spring; remove older leaves as necessary
