ADVANCED TREES

A lovely mid size tree which features lush, lime green new growth.

- Sublime™ Acmena is extremely Psyllid resistant with a thick and compact habit.
- Ideal for screening, hedges, topiary or garden features.
- Foliage is dense all the way to ground level.
- Masses of white fluffy flowers appear in summer and it rarely produces berries.
- Will tolerate a wide range of conditions from seaside gardens to cold climates with light frosts.
- Unlike most Acmena, the Sublime™ plant is an advanced tree, not a shrub.

Description	Lush green new foliage
Density	1 plant per 1.5–5 m ² 1 per 2–3 linear metres
Height & Width	5m x 2–3m
Flowering	October–December
Best Planting Time	March–November
Uses	Screening, hedges, garden features
Position	Full sun to part shade Tolerates drought & cold
Soil Type	Well drained to heavy clay loams
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; prune yearly for a tidy hedge, or every 2–3 years or not at all for a natural shape
Where it Works	QLD, NSW, VIC, SA & WA
