### Sweeper® Waterhousea is an improved form which features a heavily weeping habit.

- Gorgeous lush green new growth with a rippled leaf.
- A much denser form of Waterhousea making it an ideal plant for a medium to large dense screen.
- It makes a stunning street tree, feature plant or shade tree and is perfectly suited for harsh concrete environments where it brings a lovely softening effect.
- Sweeper® Waterhousea grows to a height of 10 metres x 5–8m wide.
- Thriving in full sun to part shade, Sweeper® Waterhousea is ideal for Queensland and NSW regions. In hot dry summers top up watering may be required.
- Produces large clusters of white flowers in summer.

<b>Description</b>	Weeping habit with lush, green new growth
<b>Density</b>	1 plant per 2–6 m <sup>2</sup> 1 per 3–8 linear metres
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	10m x 5–8m
<b>Flowering</b>	White flowers from Nov–Dec
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March–October
<b>Uses</b>	Street tree, large screen or hedge
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to part shade; Avoid hot, dry exposed areas; Tolerates drought & cold
<b>Soil Type</b>	Well drained to heavy clay loams
<b>Care</b>	Water as needed for 8–13 weeks until established; trim every 2–3 years if required
<b>Where it Works</b>	QLD, NSW, VIC, SA & WA
