

# Trixibelle™

*Correa reflexa* 'COR8' (b)

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

**Trixibelle™ Correa is a strong landscape performer, vigorous grower and is excellent for weed suppression.**

- A tough, low spreading *Correa reflexa* variety that is highly suited to landscapes due to its reasonable weed suppressing abilities.
- Trixibelle™ Correa is a fast growing form.
- It is one of the best performers out of our newly available Correas. We expect it to be a good landscape plant for the southern states.

<b>Description</b>	Low, spreading ground cover
<b>Density</b>	1-3 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 1-2 plants per linear metre
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	50cm x 2m (smaller with pruning)
<b>Flowering</b>	Pink and yellow bells in winter/early spring
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	Autumn, winter or spring
<b>Uses</b>	Good as a mass planting ground cover on large commercial developments, as a winter flowering feature plant for gardens
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to light shade; tolerates drought & frost
<b>Soil Type</b>	Preferably reasonably drained soil, however it is adaptable to most soil types
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; low water requirements once established; prune once a year to maintain compact habit or twice a year for a really tidy appearance; use slow release native fertiliser
<b>Where it Works</b>	VIC, ACT, SA, WA, TAS, Southern NSW and Sydney (in good draining soils)
