Eye catching, twisted curly foliage.

- This Dianella forms twisted curly foliage from about 8 to 12 months old and stays that way for many years.
- Twisty is good for coastal situations and can handle mild frosts. It performs best in tropical or subtropical climates and coastal temperate climates (e.g. Northern NSW and Queensland). Do not use where frosts get colder than -2°C.
- Twisty can be cut back to the ground and the foliage will grow back twisting again. It is best to avoid trimming in summer.

| Uses | Garden plantings |
| Position | Full sun to part shade; Tolerates humidity, drought & light frosts |
| Soil Type | Most soil types; avoid very poor soil |
| Care | Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; if in low nutrient soil, use slow release fertiliser in spring; remove older foliage as required, or cut back close to the ground every 2-3 years |
| Where It Works | QLD & Northern NSW |
