Lepironia articulata



A striking twisted native plant with clean foliage—ideal for rain gardens.

- Twizzler™ *Lepironia* is a great architectural element for water features, ponds, constructed wetlands, bog or rain gardens and ornamental pots.
- Suited to coastal conditions, although protection from fully exposed seaside aspects will benefit its appearance.
- In dry land gardens, it will need summer watering to work. It will not reach its full height in dry plantings.
- Twizzler™ *Lepironia* will grow in inland climates, but it needs to be protected from heavy frosts colder than -3°C.

Density	2-4 plants per m ² 1-2 per linear metre
Height & Width	1-1.3m x 40-60cm
Flowering	Conical shaped seed head Oct-Mar
Best Planting Time	March-November
Uses	Wet and moist landscapes
Position	Full sun to 70% part shade Tolerates frost & drought
Soil Type	Loam to clay loam moist soils
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; needs irrigation during summer in dry landscapes; cut back to 20cm above the ground every 3 to 5 years
Where It Works	NSW, ACT, QLD, VIC, SA, WA & TAS
