



Utopia® Dianella showcases blue and purple foliage with unique flower stems.

- An attractive feature for sheltered gardens, adding colour and beauty to any landscape.
- Utopia® Dianella prefers good draining soils or raised gardens in heavier soils and light shade.
- Although it is very hardy, drought and frost tolerant, Utopia® Dianella is not recommended for large mass plantings as it needs regular maintenance.
- It will need older foliage removed every 1–2 years.
- Fertilise Utopia® Dianella with a slow release fertiliser two months after planting and then only if required.
- Once this Dianella is established, don't over water it.



Description	Blue and purple foliage Dianella
Density	3–6 plants per m ² 2–3 per linear metre
Height & Width	50cm x 50cm
Flowering	Blue/yellow flowers from Sep–Nov
Best Planting Time	April–October
Uses	Garden plantings, foliage or accent grassy gardens as a short-medium term perennial
Position	Full sun to part shade; prefers sheltered gardens in places like Sydney and Toowoomba; tolerates frost & drought
Soil Type	Well drained soils to clay loam; avoid very poor soil types
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established, then do not over water; use slow release fertiliser after first two months, then only if required in spring; remove older foliage every 1–2 years or as needed
Where It Works	NSW, ACT, VIC, SA, WA & some parts of South East QLD (non humid regions similar to Toowoomba with free draining soil)
