

# Vintage Red™

*Eucalyptus cladocalyx* 'EUC78' (D)

ADVANCED TREES

**Vintage Red™ Eucalyptus is a proven landscape tree with no reversion: plants are staying purple-red after 6 years.**

- New foliage is a beautiful dark red, turning vivid red in sunlight, with the older foliage turning into purple and grey tones over time.
- Foliage can look almost black in certain light.
- Produces dramatic black stems which slowly develop to a rich dark red colouration.
- Propagated via grafting back onto elite *Eucalyptus cladocalyx* rootstock sourced through the CSIRO, which is a very hardy rootstock and performs very well in south east Australia.
- It is smaller than we first thought, behaving like a nana type. This makes the Vintage Red™ plant ideal for large home gardens, parks, roadsides, acreage and farms.
- Responds very well to pruning to produce denser, more compact foliage and suit smaller gardens.
- Vintage Red™ Eucalyptus has extreme drought tolerance and will live in very low rainfall areas. Will tolerate light to medium frosts.



<b>Description</b>	Red foliage Eucalyptus tree
<b>Density</b>	1 plant per 3–8m <sup>2</sup> 1 per 2–4 linear metre
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	6–8m x 3–4m
<b>Flowering</b>	March–October
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March–October
<b>Uses</b>	Attractive foliage plant or specimen tree
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to part shade; tolerates drought & cold
<b>Soil Type</b>	Sandy loam to well drained clay soils
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; for best results, prune early spring each year (essential for Sydney); keep an eye out for caterpillars and gum leaf scale (recommend planting with confidor planting tablets to control possible pests)
<b>Where it Works</b>	VIC, SA, WA & NSW (not suited north of Sydney; for Sydney only use as a maintained tree pruned annually)
