*Myoporum parvifolium* 'PARV01' (b)

## NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

This longer lived Myoporum has crisp and clean foliage with masses of white flowers.

- Very drought and frost tolerant, in addition to being successful in a wide variety of soils and climates.
- This is not a fine leaf form, it has a more typical leaf type which helps it live longer.
- Yareena™ Myoporum has thick woody stems which help it to survive longer, however these stems are covered with beautiful clean foliage so you do not see them.

<b>Description</b>	Crisp, clean, longer lived Myoporum
<b>Density</b>	1-2 plants per m <sup>2</sup>
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	10cm x 1m
<b>Flowering</b>	White flowers from Oct–March
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March–November
<b>Uses</b>	Excellent ground cover, good for coastal positions
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to part shade; tolerates drought & frost
<b>Soil Type</b>	Sandy to heavy clay soils
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; plant in a well mulched garden; prune once every two years to keep tidy
<b>Where it Works</b>	QLD, NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA & WA
