Grevillea hybrid 'RR01' (b)

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

Low growing, yet fast spreading.

- Royal Rambler™ Grevillea is a cross between 'Poorinda Royal Mantle' and 'Bronze Rambler'.
- It grows faster like 'Bronze Rambler', yet has the smaller height of 'Poorinda Royal Mantle'.
- This is a low growing ground cover with coppery red new growth foliage.
- Royal Rambler™ Grevillea is low maintenance, making it ideal for large scale gardens. It can be used in smaller gardens if pruned regularly.

Description	Low growing ground cover Grevillea
Density	1-2 plants per m ²
Height & Width	20-30cm x 2-5m
Flowering	Red flowers in late winter and spring
Best Planting Time	March-November
Uses	Ground cover, specimen plant
Position	Full sun to light shade Tolerates drought & cold
Soil Type	Light, well-drained soil types; sandy to loam; pH below 7
Care	Water as needed for 8-13 weeks until established; prune as required in spring or autumn; use slow release fertiliser sparingly or a native fertiliser as required
Where it Works	ACT, VIC, TAS, SA, WA, NSW (best suited Sydney and south, prefers free draining soils Sydney and North) & QLD (free draining soils in raised areas only)
