

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

A ground cover Callistemon with unique foliage for year-round interest.

• Ozbreed Red Rover™ Callistemon is a ground cover that will give you foliage interest year-round.

• It is strikingly different to other Callistemon, with its low growing habit and large, rounded leaf.

• It has a unique leaf shape that really makes a statement, and its stunning new red growth is a definite highlight of Ozbreed Red Rover™ Callistemon.

• Growing to a height of approximately 40cm, it can be pruned every second year for a tidy plant, or yearly for an even tidier more compact ground cover.

• The fact that the Ozbreed Red Rover[™] plant has no flowers means that it also fits into our No Bees Please[™] program.

Description	Low maintenance ground cover with red new growth and unique foliage
Density	1–2 plants per m ² 1–2 plants per linear metre
Height & Width	30-40cm x 1.5m
Flowering	No flowers
Best Planting Time	March-October
Uses	Ground cover for landscaping/ornamental use; suitable for sites where bees and pollen allergies are to be avoided
Position	Full sun to part shade Tolerates drought & frost
Soil Type	Most soil types; in humid climates like Brisbane, avoid heavy soils
Care	Water for 8–13 weeks as required until established; prune to shape if required; fertilise annually with slow release fertiliser; watch out for Webbing Caterpillar in establishment period
Where it Works	NSW, VIC, SA & South QLD (best suited to non humid regions like Toowoomba)
