An improved form of a popular Australian Native with wider, darker green foliage

- Shadow Star™ *Libertia* has a wider leaf, and also has a darker green shiny leaf.
- Larger, cleaner white flowers throughout spring.
- The Shadow Star™ plant is an excellent native alternative for those light to moderately heavy shaded areas.

Common Libertia paniculata (top) as a finer leaf than Shadow Star™ *Libertia* (bottom)



Description	Wider weeping foliage, clean white flowers
Density	4-6 plants per m ² 2-4 per linear metre
Height & Width	30-40 cm x 40-50 cm
Flowering	White flowers in spring
Best Planting Time	September - April
Uses	Mass planting, cottage gardens, containers
Position	Light - Moderately heavy shade; light frost & moderate drought tolerance once established
Soil Type	Most soil types, prefers moist with moderate drainage
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; prune early August if required
Where It Works	NSW, VIC, TAS, SA & WA
