Alternanthera dentata 'LRU30' (L)

HARDY EXOTIC PLANTS

A compact, spreading Alternanthera with beautiful deep burgundy foliage.

- Little Ruby™ Alternanthera is the perfect mounding ground cover with a compact, spreading habit.
- It is approximately a third the height of the common form and its deep burgundy colour is a real stand out in the landscape.
- In very cold climates, Little Ruby™ Alternanthera will need to be in a sheltered position, but it is more frost tolerant than the common form.
- This Alternanthera loves humidity.
