## ENCORE AZALEAS

**A tough Azalea with repeat blooming orange-red flowers.**

- Masses of orange-red blooms. Repeat blooms in spring, summer and autumn.
- It is drought and frost tolerant.
- Although it is a drought tolerant Azalea, it still needs a year to establish before it is drought tolerant. It will need top up watering during dry times.

<b>Description</b>	Tough Azalea, dense spreading habit
<b>Density</b>	1-3 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 1-2 per linear metre
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	1m x 1.2m
<b>Flowering</b>	Orange-red flowers in spring, autumn and summer
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March–November
<b>Uses</b>	Ideal for specimen and mass planting in gardens and borders
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to part shade Drought & frost tolerant
<b>Soil Type</b>	Well drained soil
<b>Care</b>	Water as required until established; top up water in dry periods; prune after spring flowering for best results
<b>Where it Works</b>	QLD, NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA & WA
