Heat tolerant Azalea with white blooms with pink flecks that repeat flower.

- This heat and cold tolerant Azalea has a medium and mounding habit.
- Autumn Starlite[™] Rhododendron has white flowers with pink flecks that repeat bloom throughout the year. It has heavy autumn, spring and summer flowering.
