- Brazilian Red Hots[™] Alternanthera is an excellent feature shrub for garden beds, containers and patio pots.
- Its brightly coloured leaves are contrasted by ball shaped white flowers in spring.
- This is a frost tender shrub, so it will need to be planted in a sheltered position to protect it from light frost.
- In frost free areas Brazilian Red Hots™ Alternanthera can be planted in full sun to part shade.
- This Alternanthera loves humidity and is heat tolerant.
- Yearly pruning will benefit this Alternanthera by promoting vibrant new growth. It will reach 50–60cm, but can be pruned to lower heights if desired.
- · Provide with adequate water as required.
