Position	Full sun to part shade Frost tolerant
Soil Type	Sandy to light clay soils
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; trim 1/3 the size annually in May–August or as required; remove spent flower heads as required, dispose of correctly if in a warmer climate or wet area; mulch well; use slow release fertiliser in late winter
