STRAPPY LEAF PLANTS

Emerald Arch® *Dianella* helps to create a warm, tropical feel in the landscape for cooler areas.

- An ornamental Flax Lily with great cold tolerance and low water requirements.
- Its wide arching leaves create contrast in the garden.
- Great in shaded gardens.

Description	Flax Lily with broad arching leaves
Density	4–6 plants per m ² 2–3 per linear metre
Height & Width	55cm x 50cm
Flowering	Blue/yellow flowers from Sep–Nov
Best Planting Time	March–October
Uses	Mass plantings and specimen plantings; low water gardens
Position	Full sun to heavy shade Tolerates frost & drought
Soil Type	Well drained to clay soils; avoid very poor soil
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; use slow release fertiliser in spring; remove older leaves as required; cut back halfway every 3–7 years
Where it Works	NSW, ACT, VIC, TAS, SA & WA
