

# Fluro Burst™

*Callistemon* spp 'CNU19' (b)

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

This *Callistemon* demands attention with its burst of hot pink bottle brush flowers.

- Fluro Burst™ *Callistemon* is a semi-compact fine leaf *Callistemon* that is great as a feature plant or for mass planting and hedging.
- Its hot fluro pink flowers add a burst of colour in Spring, and contrast beautifully with its dark green foliage.
- It has good frost and drought tolerance once established, and will tolerate full sun to partly shaded positions.
- Great for attracting bees and native birds.
- It is a low maintenance *Callistemon* that requires little to no pruning to maintain a tidy form, but can be pruned yearly to encourage a denser habit.

<b>Description</b>	Semi-compact <i>Callistemon</i> with hot pink flowers
<b>Density</b>	1-3 plants per m <sup>2</sup> 1-2 per linear metre
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	1-1.5m x 90cm-1.2m
<b>Flowering</b>	Hot pink flowers in spring
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March-October
<b>Uses</b>	Hedges, mass planting, feature plant, specimen planting and contrast planting
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to part shade
<b>Soil Type</b>	Most soil types
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established. Plant in a well mulched garden (chunky mulch is recommended). If required use slow release fertiliser in spring. If ever required, prune every 3-4 years for a natural shape, or every 2 years for a tidy hedge.
<b>Where it Works</b>	NSW, VIC, Sth QLD, SA & WA (more testing required for Nth QLD & ACT)
